
Message from the Youth Services Unit

It also provides maintenance to 27 different sports/recreational facilities to ensure they are kept in a state of readiness and safety for public use. DOS also provides guidance on sport policy matters, monitors the development of sports and provides support services for various stakeholders including Schools, Sports Clubs, Communities and Sports Associations.
